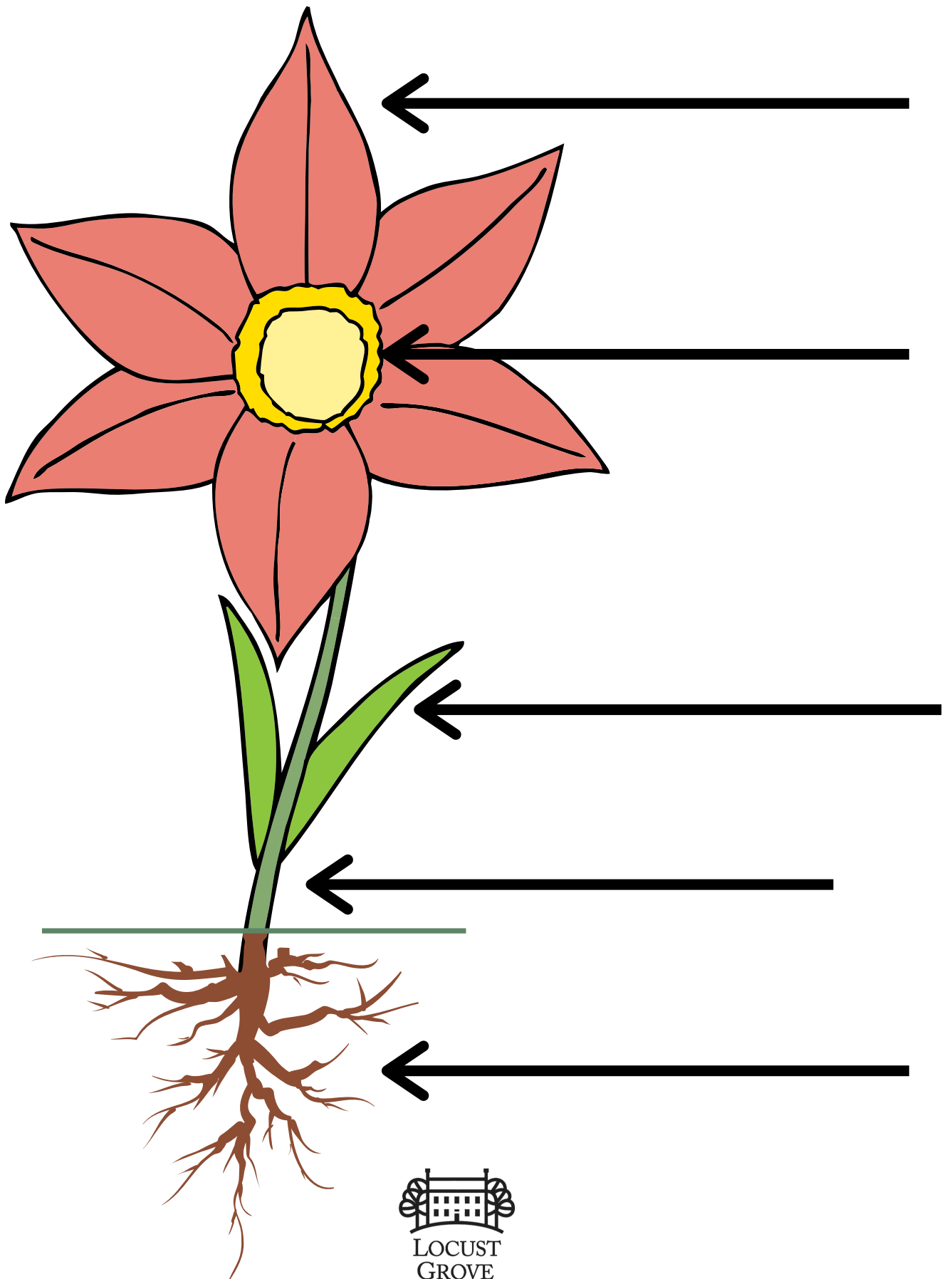


# The Parts of a Flower

# Flower Vocabulary

**GERMINATION:** The process of a plant growing from a seed into a plant or flower.

**PHOTOSYNTHESIS:** The process of plants using their leaves to absorb sunlight to make food.

**POLLINATION:** The process pollen transportation that allows plants to reproduce. The wind and rain blow pollen between plants, causing the pollen to transfer. Bees also cause pollination by carrying pollen from flower to flower.

**ROOTS:** Part of a plant hidden underground. Roots hold the plant in the ground and keeps the plant upright. They take the water and nutrients from the soil and transport them to the stem.

**STEM:** Main body of the flower that provides support for the leaves and flower, and transports water and nutrients to the rest of the flower.

**PETALS:** Colorful part of the flower that attracts insects to promote pollination.

**POLLEN:** Powdery substance produced by plants to aid in reproduction.

**LEAVES:** Provide food and air to help a plant grow. They absorb the sunlight and turn it into food.
