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Market Fair General Rules & Regulations

All Participants

Water, firewood, toilets, and straw will be provided. Please estimate the amount of straw, if any, you will need in the section of the form regarding camp details. Historic Locust Grove will be offering a Free Continental Breakfast for participants. Historic Locust Grove will have food for sale during event hours. Other food vendors are to be contacted but are not yet confirmed.

1. All tentage should be appropriate to the time and place being portrayed. No modern items visible during public hours.
2. Common Sense and Common Courtesy are a must!
3. Participants weapons must be inspected by Locust Grove/NWTA safety officers and tagged before use. NWTA Safety rules apply to this event. A copy may be requested on site or found at https://www.nwta.com/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/NWTA_Operations_Manual_Spring_2022.pdf
4. All participants no matter what age must sign Statement of Release/Parental Waiver.
5. All vehicles must be moved out of the market fair area and camp, to the designated participant parking area 8:00 am on Saturday morning. After the fair starts vehicles may not enter the area until the closing time for the event on Sunday printed on the schedule.
6. Please respect quiet hours for all nights starting at 11:00 pm.
7. Tear down begins no earlier than the closing time for the event on Sunday printed on the schedule.
8. The Designee of Locust Grove's decision is final in all questionable situations regarding the site, including the physical grounds, visitor center, historic house, all buildings, sales, and parking area as well as any other issue occurring outside of the Market Fair and encampment areas.
