Whether you're planning a wedding, family reunion, corporate retreat, charity fundraiser, or something else, let us add your story to the histories of Locust Grove.


The Grounds: Locust Grove's 55 rolling acres of fields, lawns, gardens, and orchards are a peaceful oasis just a few miles from downtown Louisville.

The Quadrant Gardens: Want an open-air space with the privacy of a room? With walls of shrubs and bushes, each garden has about 75' x 75' of lawn inside with dappled shade for ceremonies or receptions. The two quadrants nearest the Visitors' Center will accommodate 60' x 40' tents with about 150 people for a seated dinner. Without a tent, up to 250 can be seated.

Allée: At the center of the quadrant gardens, the Allée is a popular wedding ceremony location. A walkway of viburnum and Sweet Bay Magnolia line the path to the aisle, the perfect frame for photos of guests and the bride alike. The 200' dogwood-lined Allée provides a broad expanse of grass with a view of Locust Grove's historic house museum. Ceremony space is about 30' x 60' for around 250 people seated theater-style. Reception space is about 30' x 200' and comfortably seats anywhere from 25-500 people for dinner.



Audubon Room: Locust Grove's indoor event space named after one of the site's most memorable visitors. The Audubon Room has a working fireplace flanked by two sets of doors that lead to The Quadrant Gardens. Spacious enough to seat up to 150 for dinner, 130 for a reception, or more than 200 for a cocktail party.

The Visitors' Center: A modern building with modern amenities. Windows in broad ash frames give the 20' x 30' lobby an airy, outdoorsy feel as you travel through, providing a passage from the modern world to Louisville's past. Just off the Visitors' Center lobby, the brick patio alcove is the perfect spot for a small dinner party or small wedding ceremony.
